

Cumberland County Historical Society
Scots-Irish in Pennsylvania
June 8 - June 19, 2025

Join the Cumberland County Historical Society and delve into the history of the Scots-Irish on this tour that focuses on the Plantation of Ulster that began in 1609. Carlisle, Pennsylvania, has a rich Scots-Irish heritage. Carlisle and Cumberland County were prominent destinations for Scots-Irish immigrants during the 18th century. James Hamilton laid out Carlisle in 1751, and the settlement was incorporated into a borough in 1782.

Cost is \$4,999 per person for members or \$5,199 for non-members. This price is for land and estimated air. Single supplement is \$899. Join CCHS membership is only \$45 for an individual and \$55 for a family. Please see registration form for full pricing info with insurance.

This tour will visit all 9 counties of Ulster - comprising of 6 counties in Northern Ireland (Derry, Antrim, Down, Tyrone, Armagh, Fermanagh) and 3 counties in the Republic of Ireland (Cavan, Monaghan & Donegal). You will have access to a genealogist in Ireland, for a fee, and she will accompany your visit to PRONI (Public Records Office of Northern Ireland) in Belfast. This trip combines experiences of diverse culture, history, and stunning landscapes.

Sunday, June 8, 2025 Depart USA for Ireland

Monday, June 9, 2025 Arrive in Dublin and transfer to Belfast. En-route stop at the **Castlewellan Peace Maze**, one of the world's largest permanent hedge mazes symbolizing the path to a peaceful future for Northern Ireland. Then visit the **Irish Linen Centre and Lisburn Museum** where you'll learn about one of Ireland's oldest industries. Overnight: Europa Hotel Belfast (**L**)

Tuesday, June 10, 2025 Start with the **North Down Museum** which offers rich insights into the area's local history. Next, visit **Ballycopeland Windmill**, one of the only remaining working windmills in East Down. Round off today with **Mount Stewart House**, an elegant 18th-century house known for its stunning gardens. Dinner at a local restaurant is included the evening. Overnight: Europa Hotel Belfast (**B, D**)

Wednesday, June 11, 2025 Visit the historic **Crumlin Road Gaol** which gives a deep dive into prison life in 19th-century Belfast. After, journey back in time with **Titanic Belfast**, an interactive museum depicting the ill-fated ship's tragic journey. For those who have been working on genealogy you will spend the day at **PRONI**, Public Record Office of Northern Ireland. Overnight: Europa Hotel Belfast (**B**)

Thursday, June 12, 2025 Depart Belfast for Portrush, visiting **Glenarm Castle & Gardens**, a charming estate with stunning landscapes. Next, visit **Dunluce Castle**, a medieval castle found atop a dramatic craggy cliff along the emerald coasts of Northern Ireland and the famed **Giant's Causeway**, a UNESCO World Heritage site known for its interlocking basalt columns. Dinner is included at a local restaurant this evening. Overnight: Portrush Atlantic Hotel (**B,D**)

Friday, June 13, 2025 Walk the historic **Derry Walls**, then visit the **Museum of Free Derry** to learn about the city's turbulent past. Conclude the day with a visit to **St. Columb's Cathedral**, an iconic symbol of the city with deep historical Ulster roots. Dinner is included this evening at a local hotel. Overnight: Holiday Inn Express Derry (**B,D**)

Saturday, June 14, 2025 Visit **Raphoe Castle**, an impressive plantation castle. Marvel at the **Beltany Stone Circle**, a historical site home to 60+ stones erected circa 1400-800 BC. Finally, visit the **Grianan Stone Fort**, a hilltop fort offering panoramic views. Dinner is on your own this evening. Overnight: Holiday Inn Express Derry **(B)**

Sunday, June 15, 2025 Journey from Derry to Bundoran and learn about Ireland and America's shared history at the **Ulster American Folk Park**. Then, it's onto the **Wild Atlantic Distillery** to learn about the distillery process and taste locally produced spirits. Dinner is on your own this evening. Overnight: Allingham Arms Hotel Bundoran **(B)**

Monday, June 16, 2025 Depart Bundoran for Enniskillen, stopping en-route at the **Old Laghey Road**. Here, visit **Belleek Pottery**, one of Ireland's oldest crafts, and continue to the scenic **Monea Castle**. Monea Castle is a beautiful plantation castle that is nestled in the lush green countryside of Fermanagh. Dinner at your hotel is included this evening. Overnight: Allingham Arms Hotel Bundoran. **(B, D)**

Tuesday, June 17, 2025 Head from Enniskillen to Cavan. Witness the historic **Devenish Island** with its round towers via a boat tour, followed by visiting the monastic settlement at **Drumlane Abbey**. Dinner will be on your own this evening. Overnight: Cavan Crystal Hotel **(B)**

Wednesday, June 18, 2025 Begin the day at **St. Peter's Tin Church** with its unique architectural style. Visit the **Carrickmacross Workhouse**, central to Ireland's great famine story. End the day at the **Brehon Brewhouse**, home to some of Ireland's finest handcrafted beers. Farewell dinner at your hotel is included this evening. Overnight: Cavan Crystal Hotel **(B, D)**

Thursday, June 19, 2025 Say your farewells, carrying a treasure trove of memories and experiences as you transfer back to Dublin Airport for your journey home.

Overnight accommodation as noted on itinerary, breakfast daily, 1 lunch, 5 dinners, driver, guide, portage. Flight cost is estimated into the tour price and will be updated once it can be confirmed.
